



## Code of Conduct

The SMGA strives to realize its mission of incorporating the game of golf into the mental and physical rehabilitation programs of post 9/11 wounded warriors by providing golf instruction, equipment, and family inclusive golf opportunities. As part of its mission, the SMGA offers wounded warrior's ongoing playing opportunities and golf experiences to ensure that each is able to participate in the sport of golf despite the physical and mental injury. In doing so the SMGA represents a public face. The ability to continue to offer such opportunities is impacted by behavior at public golf events, and repeat invitations and partnerships are a way in which the SMGA brand is strengthened.

In order to provide guidance the SMGA has developed this agreement to outline a clear set of expectations when participating in SMGA sanctioned golf experiences and golf opportunities. Continued participation in SMGA programs is subject to the terms and conditions set forth in this reminder.

- Abusing rank or position to take unfair advantage;
- Engaging in illegal or criminal conduct;
- Misuse or abuse of alcohol or drugs;
- Verbal or physical harassment of others;
- Actual or threatened violence towards any individual or group;
- Conduct which endangers the life, safety, health, or well-being of others;
- Undue use of abusive or offensive language; and/or
- Engaging in any conduct contrary to the best interests of SMGA.
